Get a Local Spatial Development Plan Approved

- Spatial Development Frameworks filter from National to Provincial to Municipal to District Level
- Not localized enough to necessarily allow decision making based on what is good for our local community

Create a Circular Economy

- Encourage local economy (use local, buy local)
- Innovative, creative use of waste to create jobs and economic growth

- An example: horse manure to compost for permaculture projects that create jobs and nourish communities

Tread Lightly on the Earth

Masi Working Group

- 2 NRPA EXCO members participating in the Masi Working Group as a part of a joint Far South Peninsula Community Forum-Masi leaders initiative. The aim is to pool resources and to push for delivery on the suggestions made in the, yet unreleased, Masi Development Framework. Had one meeting, the 10 May meeting was cancelled due to unrest in Masi.
